2. ELIGIBILITY

The Contests are open to all Canadian residents who are eighteen (18) years of age or older who have registered for the InCanada Panel ("Contestants").

3. PROCEDURE FOR AWARDING PRIZES

Random draws will be conducted in Vancouver, British Columbia periodically during the Contest Period from amongst all Contestants.

Winner(s) will be notified by email by the Contest Administrator or a third party acting on behalf of the Contest Administrator ("Vision Critical") within fifteen (15) days of the drawings.
